

TWIN TOWERS IN CHARLESTOWN? THE SECOND-TALLEST STRUCTURES IN RHODE ISLAND – HERE?

The Charlestown Zoning Board is holding hearings to consider a proposal to build two industrial-size wind turbines off Route 1 in Charlestown.

The two structures would be 410 feet high – the same height as One Financial Plaza in Providence, the second-tallest building in RI! They would be only slightly shorter than RI's tallest building – the Bank of America building in Providence (428 ft.).

HERE IS WHAT YOU CAN DO TO STOP THESE TWO ABSURDLY LARGE STRUCTURES FROM SPOILING THE TOWN'S LANDSCAPE:
